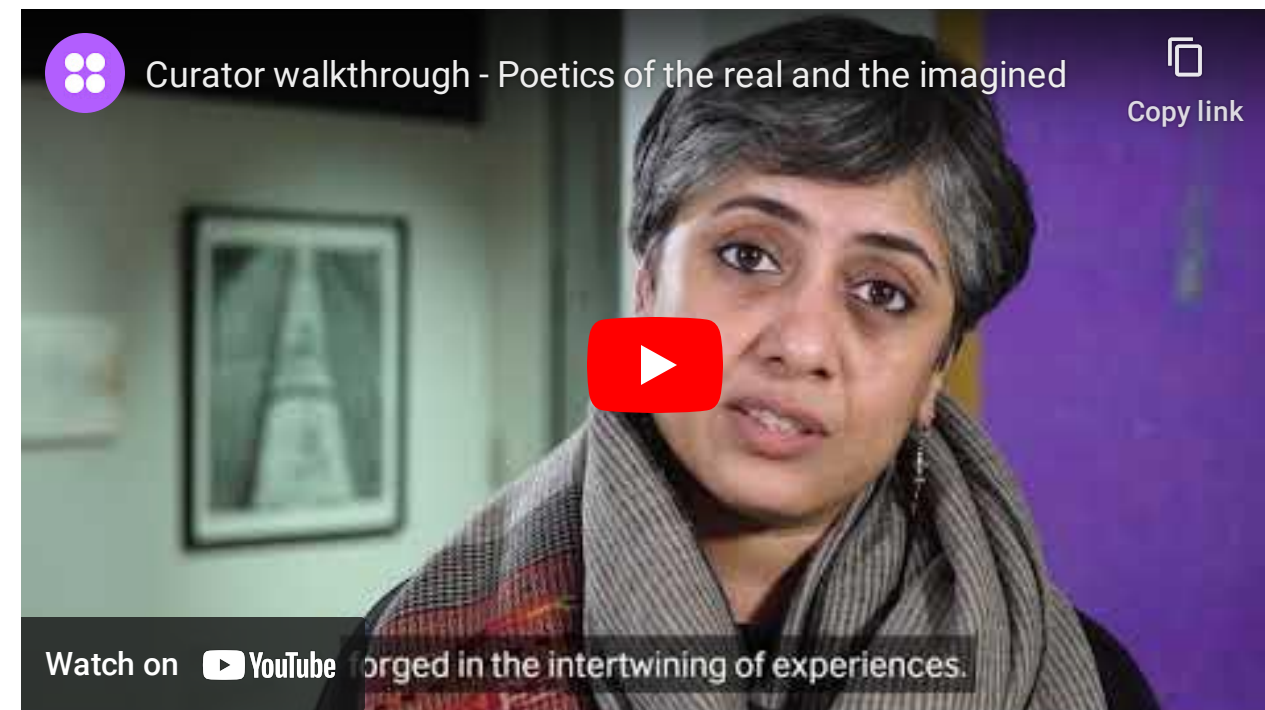
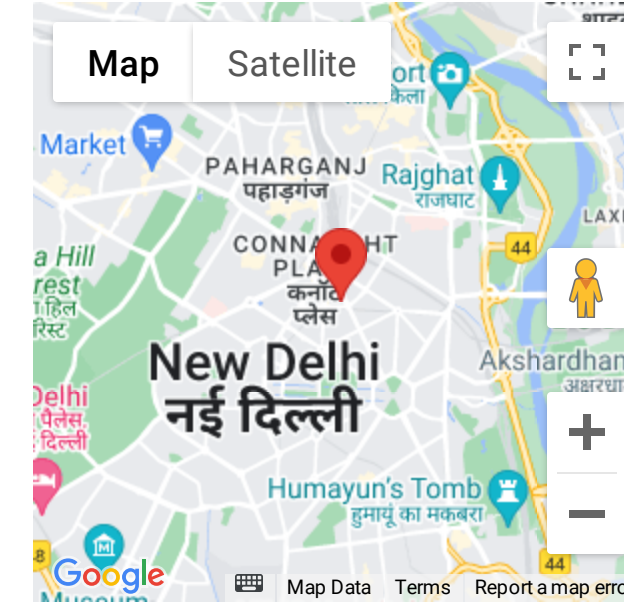


Poetics of the real and the imagined
